




 visibility, professional tools, strategic advice




INTERNATIONAL VISIBILITY OF JOURNAL

- 8 worldwide contributors semi- and peripheral journals vs. mainstream journals
- 9 TIMELY PUBLISHING
 publish or perish paradigm, early birds
- 10 JOURNAL INDEXING
 not only the mainstream databases


Topics & Topic Clusters
