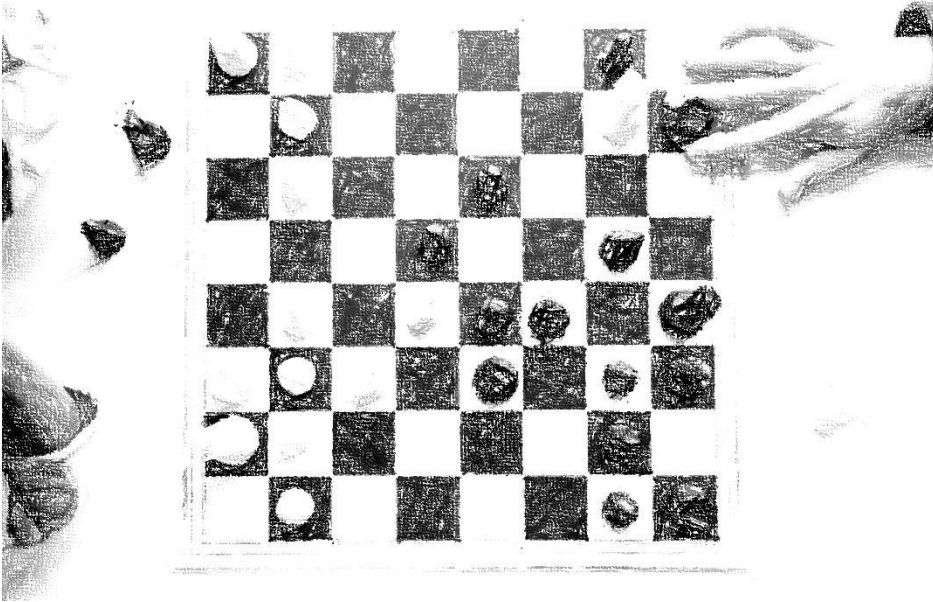

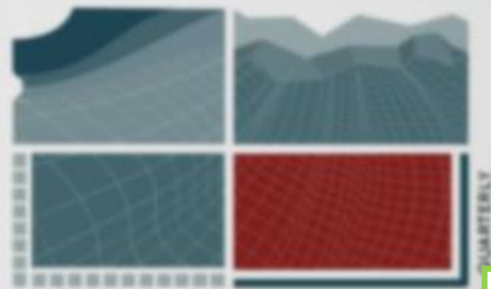

unique, English, catchy, and short*
 - 2 **ENGLISH FULL TEXT**
modern lingua franca, citations
 - 3 **HIGH-QUALITY PAPERS**
Introduction, **M**ethods, **R**esults **A**nd **D**iscussion
 - 4 **AIMS AND SCOPE**
all aspects that distinguish the journal from other titles
 - 5 **PUBLISHING HOUSE**
visibility, professional tools, strategic advice

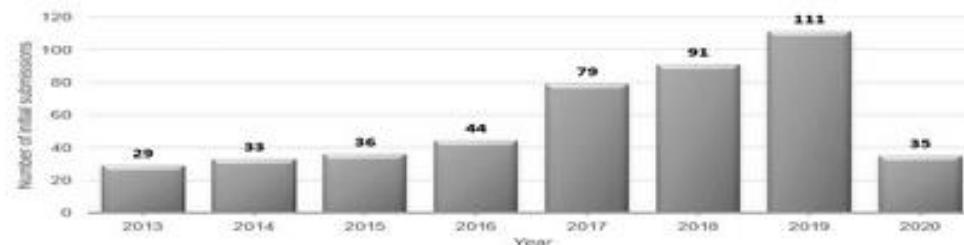

- 6 **INTERNATIONAL EDITORIAL TEAM AND EDITORIAL BOARD**
experienced scholars with publication records in Scopus and WoS
presentation on the website

external peer-reviewers, transparency of the peer-review procedure
 - 8 **WORLDWIDE CONTRIBUTORS**
semi- and peripheral journals vs. mainstream journals
 - 9 **TIMELY PUBLISHING**
publish or perish paradigm, early birds
 - 10 **JOURNAL INDEXING**
not only the mainstream databases



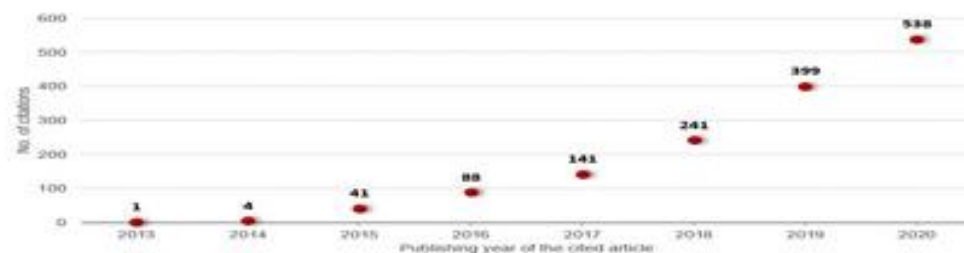

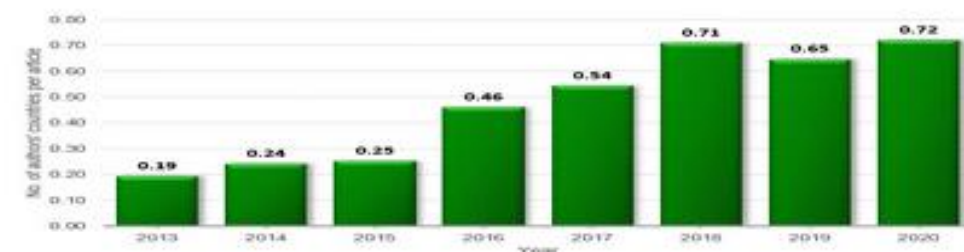

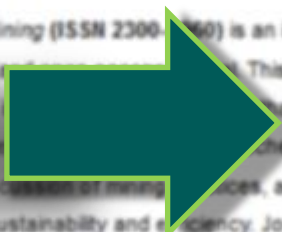

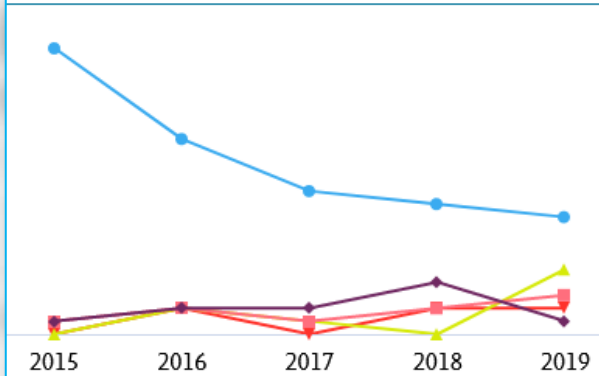

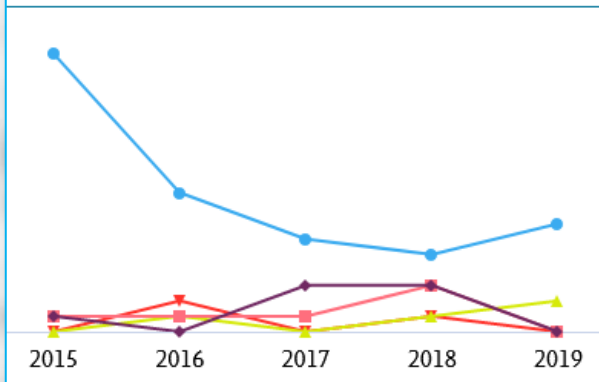
Field-Weighted Citation Impact

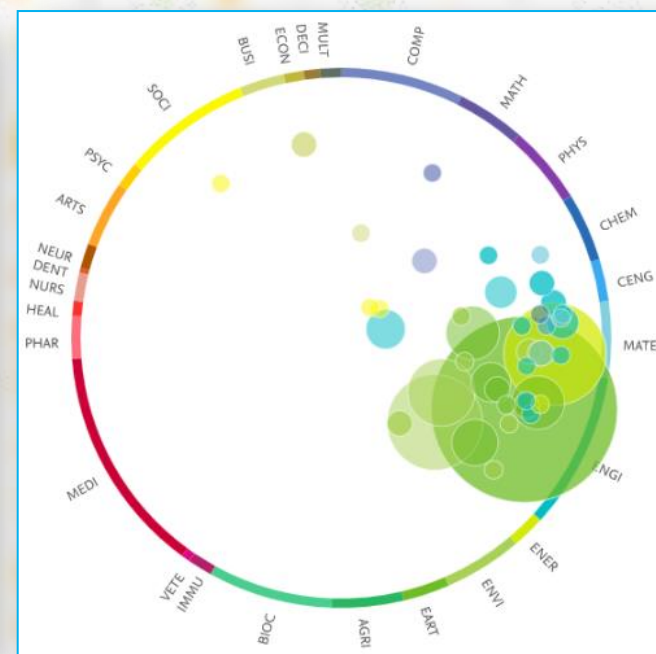
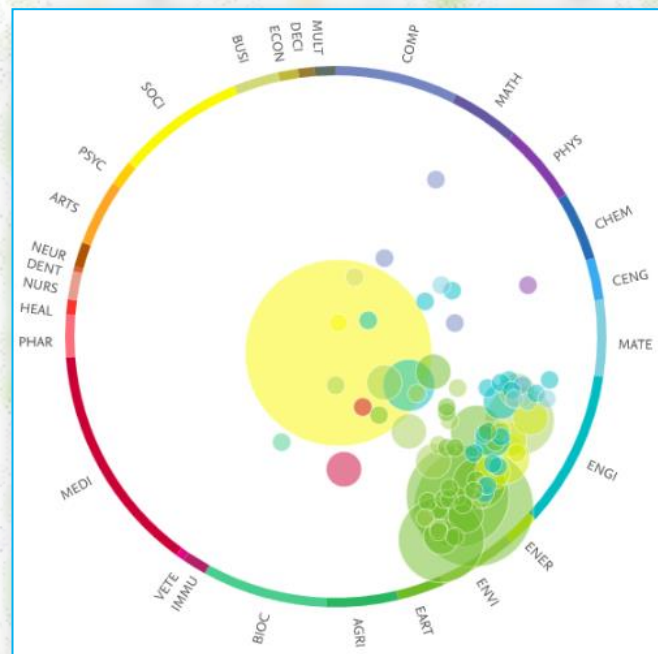
Most active Countries/Regions
