- Though the pandemic has hampered those efforts we hope to grow the program in the future.

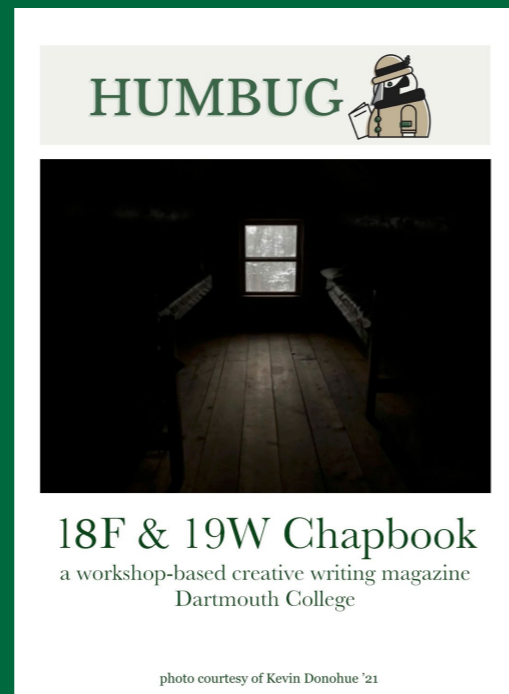


# Student Publishing at Dartmouth

- 24 active publications
  - 8 academic journals
  - 7 literary magazines
  - 3 news/politics
  - 6 other (mainly non-academic magazines)
- 104 defunct publications
- Mainly undergraduate
- Some accept non-Dartmouth authors
- Funding from Student Government
- No centralized publishing model



# Student Publishing in Dartmouth Digital Commons



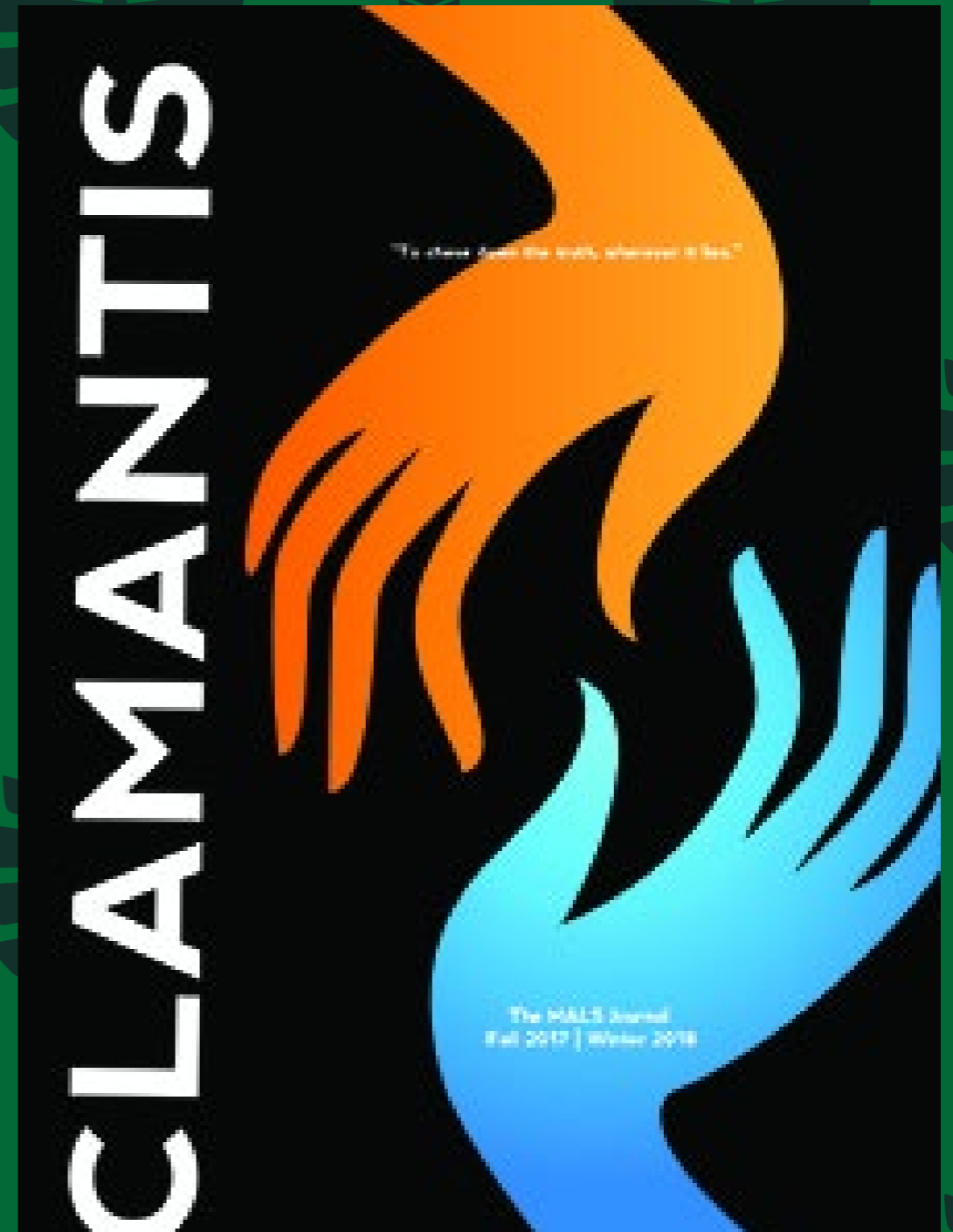

## Active journals in Dartmouth Digital Commons

- *Clamantis: the MALS Journal*
  - 2017-present
  - Published as *The Journal*, 2005-2016
  - Print, then on department site, then migrated to Digital Commons
  - Open to current and past students from the Dartmouth MALS program, and other Dartmouth graduate students
  - Editorial board: current and past Dartmouth MALS students
- Dartmouth Undergraduate Journal of Politics, Economics and World Affairs
  - 2018-present
  - Open to any undergraduate from an accredited institution
  - Editorial board: Dartmouth undergraduate students
